

## **THE QUACK IS BACK!**

KinderMourn's annual Hope Floats Ducks Race is back on Sunday, May 4, 2025, from 2 – 5:30 pm at the WWC!

For 21 years, Hope Floats has brought KinderMourn families together to raise money to help others traveling the same road. This one-of-a-kind Duck Race at the Whitewater Center brings together people of all ages to watch thousands of brave rubber ducks rush through the rapids and share a meaningful afternoon where HOPE FLOATS and loved ones are honored. To date, the race has raised more than \$3.2 million.

Each year, hundreds of parents in our community are impacted by the death of a child, and thousands of children learn all too young the devastation of having a loved one die. Every adopted rubber duck allows KinderMourn to continue its mission of providing a sanctuary and a safe haven to bereaved parents, grieving children, and teens who have suffered an unthinkable loss. Only with support from the community can we continue to heal heartaches and provide hope.

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

- It is estimated that 73,000 children die every year in the United States.
- 1 in 13 children will experience the loss of a parent or sibling before the age of 18. For youth up to the age of 25, these numbers more than double.
- Research indicates that bereavement causes significant stress for children. Unaddressed grief and trauma can lead to immediate and long-term social, emotional, and behavioral difficulties.
- In 2024, we sold out of ducks adopted at 55,000 ducks. The goal for 2024 is 60,000.
- For 46 years, KinderMourn has provided help, hope, and healing to bereaved parents and grieving children.
