



2024 Helping the Hurt Outreach


At KinderMourn, we recognize that many of our community's most vulnerable are unable to access the support needed at the KinderMourn Home. That is why, 30 years ago, in 1994, we established Helping The Hurt, a **FREE** outreach program to expand our reach in the community providing on-site grief support to children and teens in our local area schools.



2024 Demographics




"The group helped knowing that there's other people in my school who have gone through the same thing and to know how they felt, too. It felt good knowing I'm not alone."
