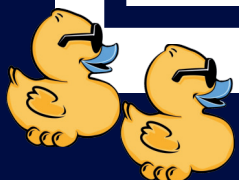

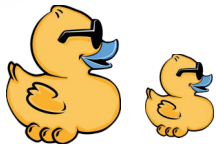

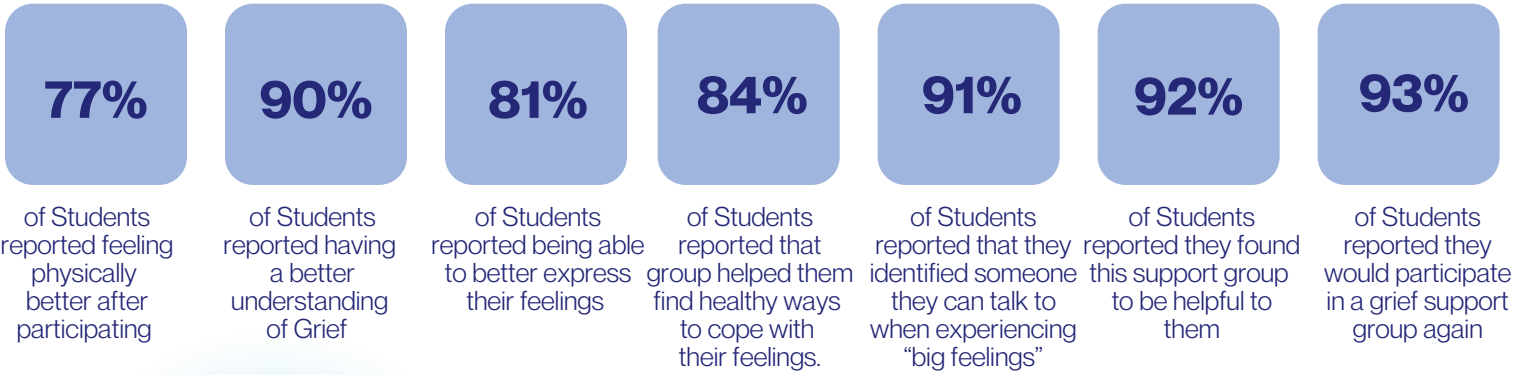


2024 CUMULATIVE SCHOOLS SERVED

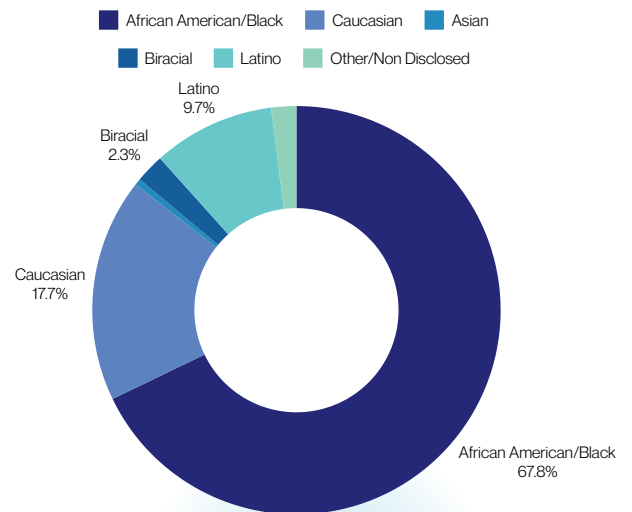
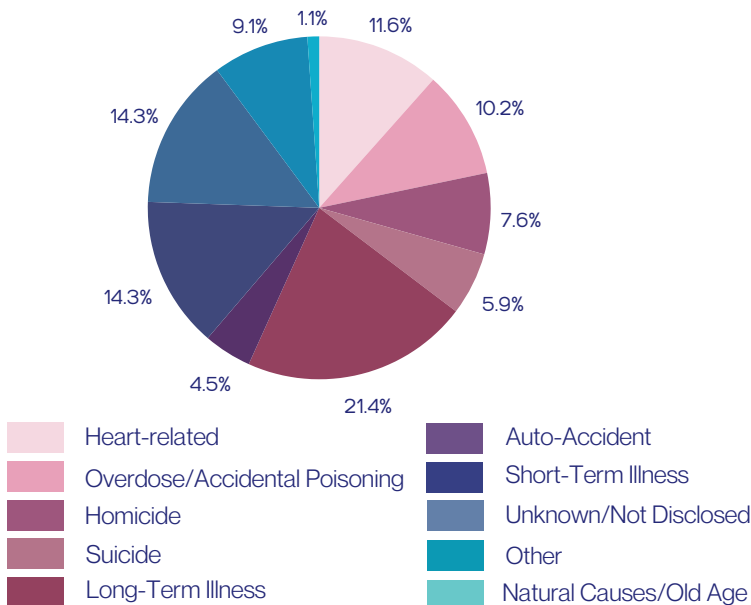

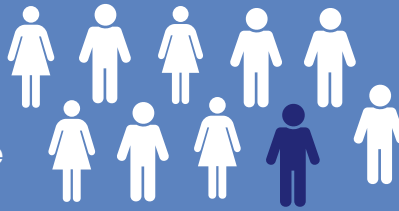


KinderMourn currently serves **1,785** bereaved families (over 705 children) in **41 cities** throughout North Carolina and South Carolina.
